On Andrews's campus, the career services are divided into two areas: **Career Development**, and **Career Placement**. Each area covers certain aspects of establishing and finding a career, and is provided by different departments.

Career Development covers areas in the first stage of development, such as: identifying your life calling, personal mentoring, career assessments, career counseling, and career planning. It also includes the next step such as resume building, cover letter writing, developing professional etiquette, practicing interview skills, graduate school assistance, and job search preparation.
