## PROGRAM STRUCTURE

### First summer

8-week immersive field course traveling across California

### Second summer

8-week internship at conservation organizations nationwide

### Winter workshop

4-day professional skills workshop and lifelong alumni support

## AM I ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

Our scholars represent over 20 majors and 50 US Colleges and Universities, and there are no GPA requirements.

Any students who do not require a student visa to study in the United States (including citizens, nationals, residents, refugees, DACA, undocumented, and more) and plan to finish a four-year degree AFTER December 2023 are eligible.
